Going back to basics 2024-2025 ALA year in review

Our American Legion Auxiliary administrative year focused on educating members to better serve the mission.

After being elected national president, Trish Ward from the Department of Kansas visited all 52 ALA departments during her term, a feat last accomplished in the Auxiliary's 2010-2011 administrative year.

Ward focused on educating members on ways to build leadership and membership. Getting back to the grassroots of moving the mission forward energized units and departments to recruit and retain members.

The Department Excellence Initiative training led to effective dialogue among members and compelling discussions on ways to engage each other and support the ALA's smaller units.

During the administrative year, we celebrated our 105th as an organization,

continuing to focus on the difference we've made over the decades for our veterans, military, and their families.

Events that benefit and educate

Members attended five Mission Trainings throughout the country to learn more about giving back to the organization's mission, along with many hands-on activities and discussions to enhance the overall experience.

National Junior meetings took place alongside the Mission Trainings, focusing on our younger ALA members, teaching them more about the organization, and how to serve our veterans, military, and their families. New this year: including young Sons of The American Legion members as part of the meetings.

Together, they learned about the importance of the poppy, the ALA's relationship with Wreaths Across America (WAA), and Honor Flight Network — all while participating in fun, educational games and service projects. For WAA, Juniors and Sons made small wreaths to take back to their units and squadrons and explain the partnership



with the organization. For Honor Flight, they made mail call cards which are distributed on Honor Flights to veterans as a thank-you for their service.

A milestone partnership between ALA and NVCAF

In 2025, the National Veterans Creative Arts Festival came to Indianapolis, home of ALA National Headquarters. This was the first time in its over 40-year history that the Festival was held in Indiana. The May event marked 25 years of participation with the ALA at the national level. Since 2014, the ALA has co-presented the event alongside the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, but has been involved in the Festival in some capacity since 2000. To help celebrate the milestone year, veterans performed a special song with a thank-you message at the stage show to honor the ALA and its years of involvement.



Two big events to wrap up the administrative year

ALA Girls Nation and National Convention are positive, uplifting events, according to the people who attend them.

The external-facing ALA Girls Nation gives our organization a chance to put our name and mission out there to girls from across the country, who can take back what the ALA is about to their respective states, schools, and communities.

National Convention is a great recap of the year, highlighting all of the amazing work our members accomplished while working the mission. Hearing from national officers and committee chairs on how our members helped veterans, military, and their families rejuvenates members and is a perfect ending to the administrative year — a big celebration!

ALA Academy courses for continued training

Annually, ALA Academy courses help members learn new ideas and dive deeper into

our programs. Throughout 2024-2025, several ALA Academy Live courses were offered on a variety of subjects ranging from leadership and mentoring to how to apply for an Auxiliary Emergency Fund grant to unlocking your member benefits. Some courses streamed at lunchtime and others were evening sessions, giving members a variety of times that would work with their schedules.

In addition to the live virtual webinars, there are self-paced courses members can take at anytime. There's also a course specifically designed for Junior members: *ALA Juniors E-Learning Course*.
