Saturday Evening: Senators are sworn in as citizens of ALA Girls Nation

Sunday Morning: ALA Girls Nation is organized into 8 communities. Each

community will consist of Senators in the Federalist or Nationalist Party and will elect 2 Party Delegates. Eight Senators for each party are eligible to run for Party Chairman, Party Vice-chairman, Party Secretary. The other five delegates are appointed as committee

chairmen.
